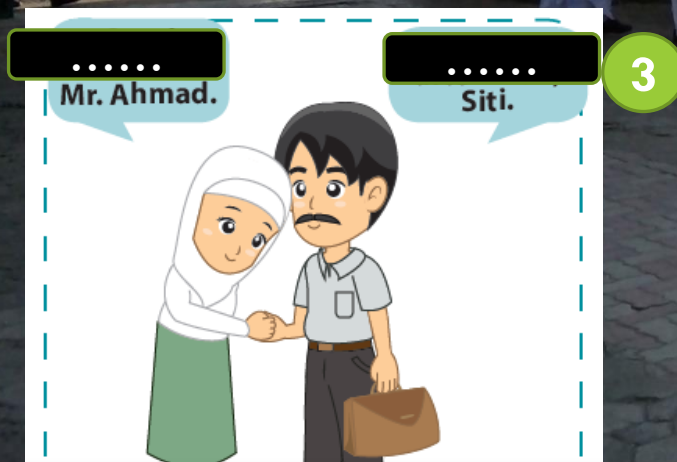

Formal and Informal Greetings

Formal Greetings

- Good morning
- Good afternoon
- Good evening
- How do you do?
- How are you?

Formal Responses

- Good morning
- Good afternoon
- Good evening
- Very well, thank you

Formal closings

- It has been a pleasure, goodbye
- Thank you for your time, goodbye

Informal Greetings

- Hello
- Hi
- How are you doing?
- How have you been?
- How are things going?

Informal Responses

- Hello/Hi
- Hi
- Fine, thanks and you?
- Great, thanks

Informal closings

- I have to go now, bye
- I'll see you later/around, bye
- Have a nice day, bye

Compare how to ask someone's condition in **formal** and **informal** greetings?

FORMAL GREETINGS

Hello!

How are you?

How are you doing?

How is everything?

How's everything going?

How have you been keeping?

I trust that everything is well.

It's been too long.

What have you been up to all these years?

INFORMAL GREETINGS

Hi.

What's up?

Good to see you.

How are things (with you)?

How's it going?

How's life been treating you?

Long time no see.

How come I never see you?

FORMAL GREETINGS

Formal Greeting adalah ucapan salam atau sapaan yang disampaikan dalam konteks, keadaan, dan suasana yang formal;

- ✓ konteks bisnis,
- ✓ pertemuan pertama,
- ✓ orang yang lebih tua,
- ✓ orang yang kita hormati.

Meskipun secara umur sama dengan kita atau bahkan lebih muda.

Formal Greeting identik dengan ucapan dan sapaan yang menjunjung sopan santun. Formal Greeting tidak menggunakan bahasa gaul.



FORMAL GREETINGS

EXAMPLE:

Benjamin: Good morning. *Let me introduce myself, Miss. I'm Benjamin and you can call me Ben.*

Alora : Good morning, Mr. Ben. *My name is Alora, and you can call me Alo. Nice to meet you*

Benjamin: Nice to meet you too, Miss Alo



INFORMAL GREETINGS

- ✓ Informal greeting merupakan sapaan yang biasa dipakai dalam keadaan atau acara yang tidak resmi.
- ✓ Biasanya dipakai untuk percakapan bersama sahabat atau teman yang sudah kita kenal.
- ✓ Selain itu, kita juga bisa memakai sapaan ini untuk memulai percakapan dengan orang yang baru kita kenal – dengan syarat, acaranya tidak resmi.



INFORMAL GREETINGS

EXAMPLE for informal greeting:

Hi.

What's up?

How are things?

Good to see you.

How's life?

- Nice to meet you.

- How is it going?
- How are things?
- What's up?
- How is everything?
- How's life?
- Long time no see!



- Good morning : 12.01 a.m. – 12.00 a.m.
- Good afternoon : 12.01 a.m. – 06.00 p.m.
- Good evening : 06.00 p.m. – 12.00 p.m.
(when you meet someone)

- Good night : the time you go to bed,
saying good bye in the evening

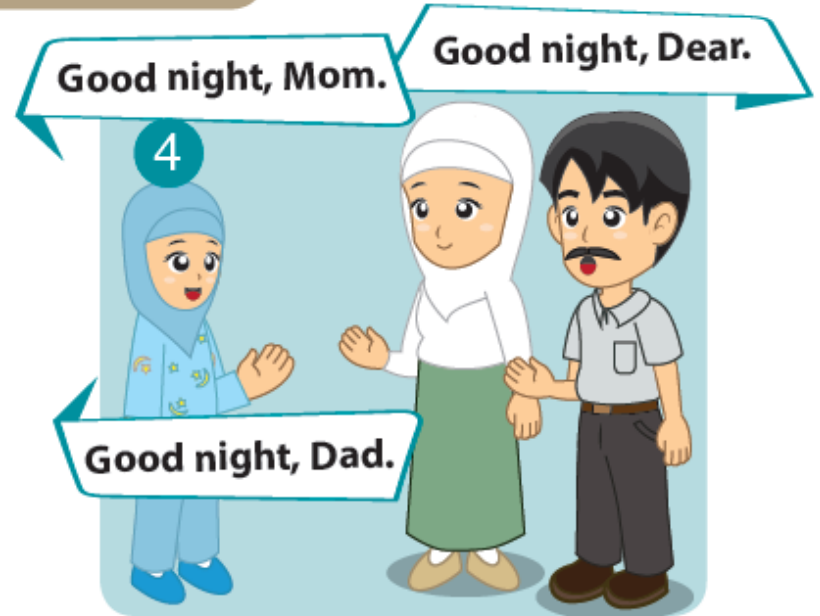
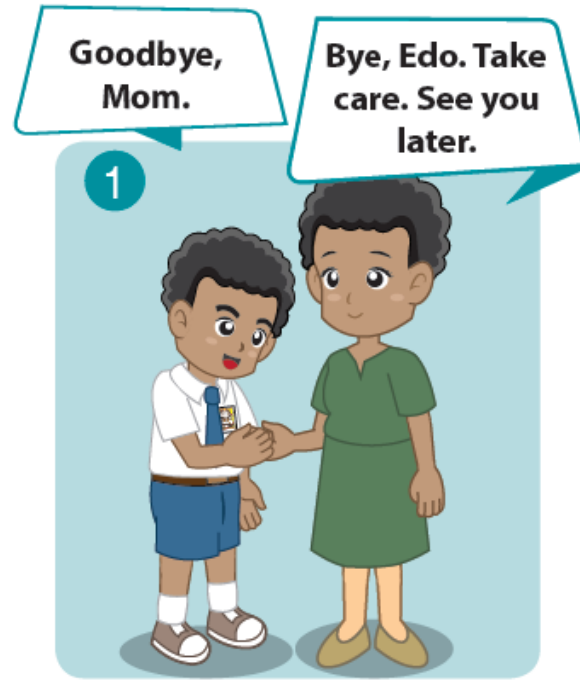

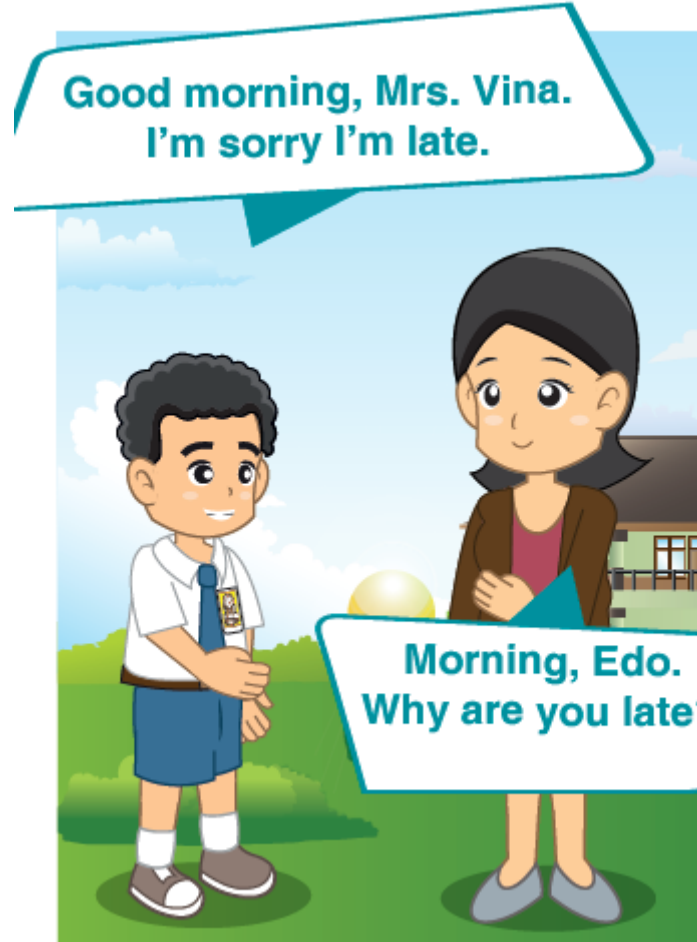
